## A new season is coming - 2/21/21

2 Pet. 3:3-4 "Knowing this first, that there shall come in the last days scoffers ... saying, Where is the promise of his coming? for since the fathers fell asleep, all things continue as they were from the beginning of the creation.

Oh we've heard this for years. But remember, God's timing is perfect.

Isa 30:18 - "And therefore will the LORD wait, that he may be gracious unto you, ... blessed are all they that <u>wait</u> for him." God is adjusting world events

The Lord visits those who rejoice in him and work righteousness ... "You meet him that rejoices and works righteousness ... Isaiah 64:5, KJV.

Let's keep faith and expectation in our hearts, ... keep a rejoicing spirit. We are preparing ourselves for a new move of God. New season coming! Isa 64:4 For since the beginning of the world men have not heard, nor perceived by the ear, neither hath the eye seen, O God, beside thee, what he hath prepared for him <u>that waiteth for him</u>. 1Co 2:9\* But as it is written, Eye hath not seen, nor ear heard, neither have entered into the heart of man, the things which God hath prepared for them that love him.

Let's not grow weary, or feel like giving up, or be doubtful or skeptical. Let us keep great faith and Great expectation in our hearts. God is about to do phenomenal things. Amen!

## We are preparing for a new move of God

God moves where there is unity. Unity is very important for revival. Acts 2:1 And when the day of Pentecost was fully come, they were all with one accord in one place. Then God moved suddenly.

God wants to bring <u>new unity</u>, and closeness to each other. Rom. 15:7 says: "Receive [or accept] one another, as Christ also [accepted] us, to the glory of God.

We are all uniquely different. Different priorities, different perspectives, Different strengths, different weaknesses.

We are to bear one another's burdens, Gal. 6:2. Encourage one another.

To forbear [or show tolerance and patience] with one another in love. Eph 4:2\* With all lowliness and meekness, with longsuffering, forbearing one another in love;

The very nature God is to be gracious, according to Exodus 34:6: The Lord describes himself like this: Ex 34:6 The LORD God, merciful and gracious, longsuffering, and abundant in goodness and truth. Let us maintain a rejoicing spirit, and a thankful spirit. 1 Thes. 5:16 We must not focus on the dark / gloomy things that are happening today. Let us focus on the light, on the Lord. Great things are coming.

Psalm 30:5. weeping may endure for a night, but joy cometh in the morning. Things may look bleak at the moment, but a new day is about to break.

Psalm 30:11 Thou hast turned for me <u>my mourning into dancing</u>: thou hast put off my sackcloth, and girded me with gladness; We have a very bright future.

Revival is coming. The Lord himself is coming. The Resurrection is coming. The millennium is coming. Satan and all evil spirits will be removed. There will be peace on earth for 1000 years.

We have a very bright future.

Things maybe dark right now, but joy comes in the morning.

## Are we in the same mood as the Holy Spirit? Often we are not!

Samuel was <u>weeping</u> for King Saul. God said, stop weeping for Saul. Sarah was laughing about the birth of Isaac in her old age. God said, why is Sarah laughing. I'm not laughing. Isaac will be born.

Ps. 2:1-4, the Lord laughs at the wicked who trying to out smart God.

"Why do the [nations] rage, and the people imagine a vain thing? The kings of the earth and the rulers take counsel together, against the LORD, and against his anointed, saying, Let us break their bands asunder, and cast away their cords from us. He that sitteth in the heavens <u>shall laugh</u>: the Lord shall have them in derision."

At other times, God is <u>weeping</u> because of the wickedness of man, and because there is no repentance, and he has to send terrible judgment. Example: at the time of the flood. Let's read please Eccl. 3:4 Eccl. 3:4 A time to weep, and a time to laugh; a time to mourn, and a time to dance; .... Let us stay in the same mood as the Holy Spirit.

Often we are not in the same mood as the Holy Spirit. Check your thoughts. I often ask myself, are these thoughts coming from the Holy Spirit? Are these feelings that I have coming from the Lord? It is good ask ourselves these questions. To challenge thoughts / feelings.

"Beloved, believe not every spirit, but [test] the spirits whether they are of God: ... 1 John 4:1, KJV.

We are preparing ourselves for a new day! Revival is coming. We are on the threshold of a totally new move of God. Read Isaiah 43:18-19:

"Remember not the former things, neither consider the things of old. Behold, I will do a new thing; now it shall spring forth; shall ye not know it? I will even make a way in the wilderness, and rivers in the desert."

Isaiah 35:3-6, - "Strengthen the weak hands, and confirm the feeble knees. Say to them that are of a fearful heart, Be strong, fear not: behold, your God will come with vengeance, even God with a recompence; he will come and save you. Then the eyes of the blind shall be opened, and the ears of the deaf shall be unstopped. Then shall the lame man leap as an hart, and the tongue of the dumb sing: for in the wilderness shall waters break out, and streams in the desert."

In this next revival, <u>healing and miracles</u> will be very preeminent. Jesus healed whole cities; He said you will do <u>greater things</u> than this. "And Jesus went about all Galilee, teaching in their synagogues, and preaching the gospel of the kingdom, <u>and healing all manner of sickness</u> <u>and all manner of disease</u> among the people." Matthew 4:23, KJV. "And Jesus went about all the cities and villages, teaching in their synagogues, and preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and <u>healing every</u> <u>sickness and every disease</u> among the people." Matthew 9:35, KJV.

People need to see the miraculous power of God, to help them believe. Joh 4:48\* Then said Jesus unto him, Except ye <u>see</u> signs and wonders, ye will not believe.

Let's ask God to change our tune. David talks about a New song.

Ps 40:3 And he hath put a new song in my mouth, even praise unto our God: many shall see it, and fear, and shall trust in the LORD.

We believe the season for God's outpouring is very close. We are to ask the Lord for the latter rain, in the time of latter rain:

Zec 10:1 Ask ye of the LORD rain in the time of the latter rain; Jas 5:7\* Be patient therefore, brethren, unto the coming of the Lord. Behold, the husbandman waits for the precious fruit of the earth, and hath long patience for it, until he receive the early and latter rain.

The Lord will not come until the latter rain is poured out. The precious fruit of the earth, are a beautified people, the church. Let's pray for the outpouring of the latter rain, the end Time revival.

In first Kings 18:43-45: Elijah had to pray seven times before the rain came. The man of God patiently prayed over and over again, before the rain came. There had been no rain for nearly 4 years, then came a torrential downpour. Let's continue to be persistent, and keep our hearts filled with faith. The rain is coming... revival is coming. God is using this present world crisis, to prepare us for the end time revival. God is exposing wickedness in high places, and is going to remove them.

Let us be greatly encouraged, and let us continue to pray. Especially pray for breakthrough and healing signs and wonders. Amen
